

PROXIMITY OF THE VENUES

OLYMPIC SPORTS COMPLEX (OAKA), THE VENUE FOR SWIMMING, WATER POLO AND DIVING, WAS BUILT IN 1991 AND BECAME A PART OF THE FACILITIES OF THE OLYMPIC ATHLETIC CENTRE OF ATHENS 'SPIROS LOUIS'.

TWO MODERN AQUATIC COMPLEXES, ONE OUTDOOR AND ONE INDOOR, WERE CONSTRUCTED IN AN AREA OF 70 ACRES. SEVERAL MAJOR EVENTS HAVE BEEN HOSTED IN THE OLYMPIC AQUATIC CENTRE, SUCH AS THE MEDITERRANEAN AND EUROPEAN SWIMMING GAMES OF 1991. THE MAIN EVENT HELD HERE OF COURSE, STILL REMAINS THE AQUATIC EVENTS AT THE ATHENS 2004 SUMMER OLYMPIC GAMES.

OPEN WATER SWIMMERS WILL ENJOY THE MOST BEAUTIFUL OPEN WATER COURSE, IN THE PITORESC PORT OF ZEA IN PIRAEUS.

PLEASANT STAY AND QUICK TRANSPORTATION FROM THE ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES TO THE COMPETITIONS.


